




# Iraq makes deal to trade captured Americans

Deal would trade them for terrorists who stole college papers

Today in Baghdad a top Iraqi official claimed that Iraq would release the two detained Americans in exchange for the pro-Iraqi terrorists that stole and burned an entire week's run of *The Rhode Island College Anchor* newspaper.
