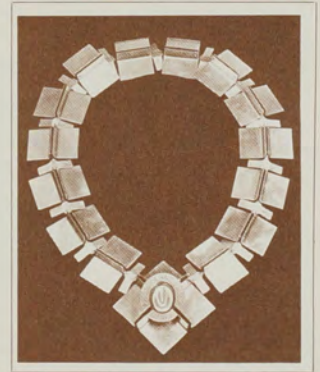


THE DEL SESTO MACE

At the 1959 Commencement Exercises, the first held on the present Mount Pleasant campus, Governor Christopher Del Sesto presented to Rhode Island College a bronze replica of the statue of the Independent Man so that the College, which up to that time had been located near the State House, might continue its tradition of holding commencements and other academic convocations in the presence of the Independent Man. The Del Sesto Mace, designed by the noted Rhode Island sculptor, the late Aristide Cianfarani, and crafted by the Gorham Company, has been in use since 1962 in all academic processions as symbolic of tradition and authority and, as well, of Rhode Island College's commitment to the search for truth, knowledge, beauty, values, and learning.

THE WILLARD MEDALLION

The Willard Medallion, symbol of the office of the presidency and worn at official and ceremonial occasions, links plates bearing the names of the chief executive officers who have led Rhode Island College since 1973. The sterling silver collar with enamel medallion was commissioned by the Rhode Island College Alumni Association and designed by silversmith Curtis K. LaFollette to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Charles Borromeo Willard as the first alumnus to be named president of the College.



THE RHODE ISLAND COLLEGE SEAL

The official Rhode Island College seal, adopted in 1960, incorporates the anchor, symbol of hope and of the State of Rhode Island, with the founding date of the institution, 1854, and features the Flame of Life, adapted from the Holbrook Murals in the foyer of Roberts Hall. The flame is used in the murals to depict the energy that has supported over the aeons the development of all living things and has led man to his highest intellectual achievements. In like manner, the flame in the Rhode Island College seal stands for the life of the body and the life of the mind, symbolizing the human and intellectual goals and achievements of Rhode Island College.



HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

JAMES SCHEVILL

James Schevill, noted poet and playwright, taught at the California College of Arts and Crafts and San Francisco State University before his appointment to the faculty as professor of English at Brown University in 1968. Upon graduation from Harvard University in 1942 he joined the United States Army and served four years during World War II. His extraordinary talent was evident as early as 1945; while still in the Army, he wrote a play for radio, *The Sound of a Soldier*, which won a National Theater Competition. His works include 31 plays which have been performed in theatres from coast to coast and in Canada and England. Among them is a full-length musical, *High Sinners, Low Angels*, and the *Bloody Tenet*, a verse play about the trial of Roger Williams in 1636, which was commissioned by the National Council of Churches and the Central Congregational Church. It has played in San Francisco, Chicago, in England and Holland, and in a number of church and community theatres throughout the United States. Two of Schevill's full-length plays, *Lovecraft's Follies* and *Cathedral of Ice*, have been produced by the Trinity Square Repertory Company. James Schevill's most recent accomplishments are *Cult of Youth*, produced at the Playwrights Center in Minneapolis in 1984, and *Old Groucho's Game*, produced by the Rhode Island Playwrights Theater in Providence in 1985.

In addition, Mr. Schevill has published 27 works, both plays and poetry, the most recent of which were released in 1985 and include *The Invisible Volcano*, *A Long Poem*, *Oppenheimer's Chair*, *A Short Play*, and *Collected Short Plays*. He has also edited *Six Historians* by Ferdinand Schevill, coedited the *Wastepaper Theater Anthology* which includes four of his own short plays, and along with Margot Schevill, recorded *Performance Poems*. Since 1960 James Schevill has given numerous readings at colleges and universities throughout the United States and as far away as London and East Germany. At present, he serves on the board of the Trinity Square Repertory Company.

Winner of many awards and the recipient of highly prized fellowships and grants such as the Guggenheim Fellowship in Poetry in 1981 and the McKnight Fellowship in Playwriting in 1984, Mr. Schevill makes his home in Providence.



MARY ANN QUARANTA

Mary Ann Quaranta has served as dean of Fordham University's Graduate School of Social Service for over 10 years. During this time she has provided leadership for improving the quality of educational offerings, increased research and publication productivity by faculty, provided administrative direction for increased enrollment, promoted the development of a master's program at Tarrytown, established a doctoral program, initiated creative program development of special projects, and initiated and completed fundraising activities for the establishment of two endowed chairs.

Dr. Quaranta began her career as a psychiatric social worker following completion of a B.S. from the College of Mount Saint Vincent and an M.S.S.S. from Fordham University and opened a private practice with which she is still actively involved. Several years later, she was appointed to Fordham's faculty and rose through the ranks to full professor, a rank she holds today. While concurrently serving as director of field instruction and as coordinator of the Fordham University Graduate School of Social Service Extension Program, and prior to her appointment to the deanship, Dr. Quaranta earned a doctor of social work from Columbia University.

Mary Ann Quaranta, researcher, scholar, and published author, has an extraordinary record of community leadership. At the international level she serves as vice president for North America of the International Federation of Social Workers, and is on the Executive Committee and the Board of the federation; she is also a member of the United States Committee, International Council on Social Welfare. At the national level, Dr. Quaranta serves as president of the National Conference of Catholic Charities, is a member of the National Conference of Deans and Directors of Graduate Schools of Social Work, and is a chairperson on the Long Range Planning Committee of the Council on Accreditation of Services to Families and Children. At the regional level, she is on the Boards of Directors for Welfare Research, Inc. and the Astor Home for Children.

Dr. Quaranta received an honorary degree from Dominican College in 1980, the same year in which Fordham University bestowed upon her the Distinguished Alumna Award. She makes her home in Blauvelt, New York.



HENRY J. SHELTON

A native of Rhode Island, Henry J. Shelton has dedicated his life to helping his fellow citizens fight injustice in the social system. He studied at St. Raphael and Stonehill Colleges before completing his education at St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore where he earned both a B.A. in 1953 and an STB in 1955. Returning to Rhode Island, he served the priesthood for nine years at St. Jude's Church in Lincoln before a transfer in 1966 to the directorship of the Catholic Inner City Apostolate in Providence provided him with the opportunity to learn the dynamics of organizing community organizations. In 1972 he left the priesthood to marry former nun Carol Reagan. They moved to Washington, D.C., where, at the National Urban and Ethnic Affairs Center, Mr. Shelton worked closely with the late George A. Wiley who was to become the inspiration for the development, years later, of the George A. Wiley Center. The center, founded in 1981 by Henry Shelton, who has served as its director since that time, is a resource center for community groups in Rhode Island. It provides a strategy for research assistance, fundraising support, and it promotes access to the media for new and established groups that comprise the elderly, the unemployed, citizens groups, and welfare rights groups. Wiley founded the Movement of Economic Justice, which serves as the model for the George A. Wiley Center today.

Mr. Shelton's far reaching accomplishments include founding the Catholic Inner city Apostolate, initiating the Rhode Island Fair Welfare Association, creating the Rhode Island Senior Citizens Action Committee, developing the Rhode Island Workers Association, providing the initiative for the formation of the Coalition of Consumer Justice and the Workers Association to Guarantee Employment, and successfully writing the grant proposals which funded these activities.

In addition to his efforts on behalf of Rhode Island's citizenry, Henry Shelton has taught classes and conducted workshops at the Community College of Rhode Island, the University of Rhode Island, Rhode Island College, and Bryant College. The Sheltons have five children, the youngest of whom is nearly two and the eldest twelve. They make their home in Cranston.

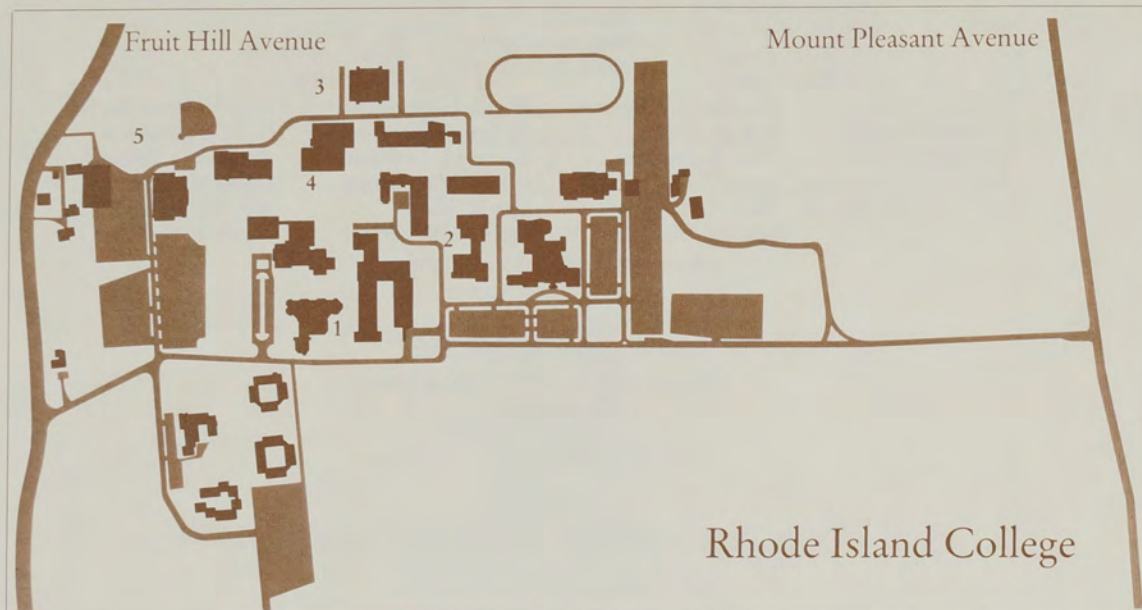

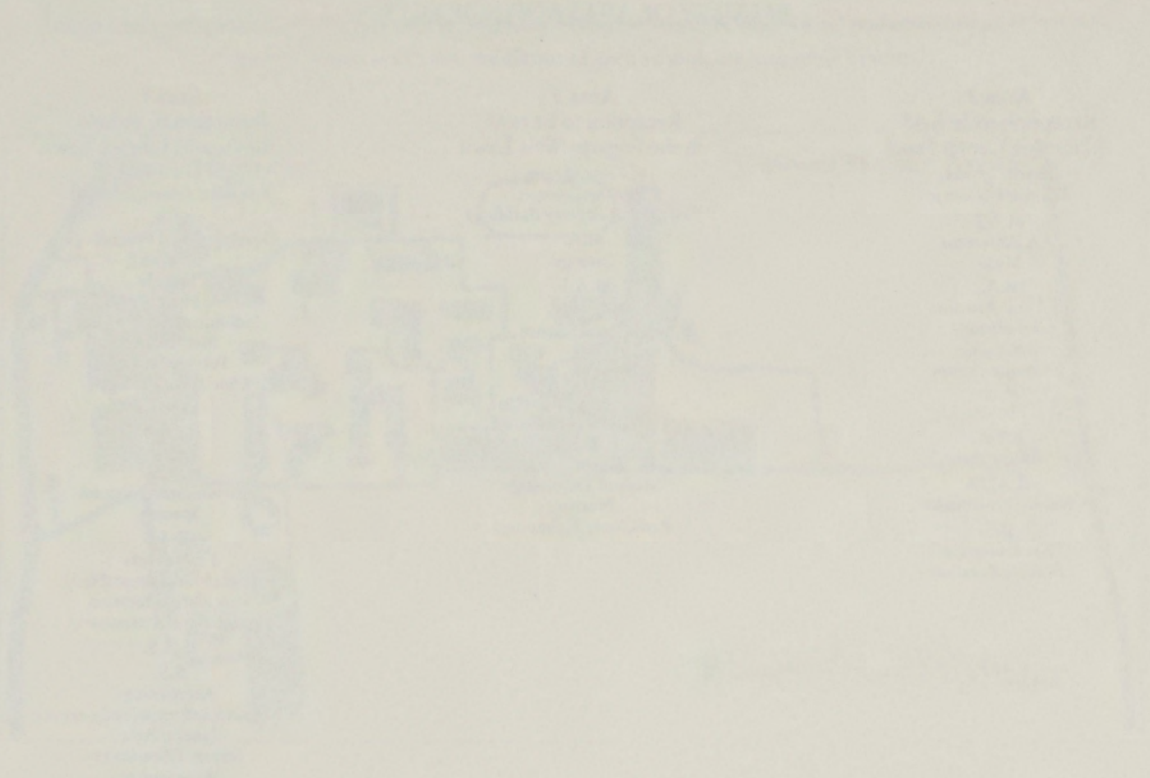
