THE DEL SESTO MACE

At the 1959 Commencement Exercises, the first held on the present Mount Pleasant campus, Governor Christopher Del Sesto presented to Rhode Island College a bronze replica of the statue of the Independent Man so that the College, which up to that time had been located near the State House, might continue its tradition of holding commencements and other academic convocations in the presence of the Independent Man. The Del Sesto Mace, designed by the noted Rhode Island sculptor, the late Aristide Cianfarani, and crafted by the Gorham Company, has been in use since 1962 in all academic processions as symbolic of tradition and authority and, as well, of Rhode Island College's commitment to the search for truth, knowledge, beauty, values, and learning.

THE WILLARD MEDALLION

The Willard Medallion, symbol of the office of the presidency, which is worn at official and ceremonial occasions, links plates bearing the names of the chief executive officers who have led Rhode Island College since 1973 in a sterling silver collar with enamel medallion. It was commissioned by the Rhode Island College Alumni Association and designed by silversmith Curtis K. LaFollette (professor of art at the College) to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Charles Borromeo Willard as the first alumnus to be named president of the College.

THE RHODE ISLAND COLLEGE SEAL

The official Rhode Island College seal, adopted in 1960, incorporates the anchor, symbol of hope and of the State of Rhode Island, with the founding date of the institution, 1854. The seal was designed by Dr. Edith C. Becker, professor emerita of art, who adapted the central flame symbol from the Holbrook Murals in the foyer of Roberts Hall. The flame is used in the murals to depict the energy that has supported over the aeons the development of all living things and has led man to his highest intellectual achievements. In like manner, the flame in the Rhode Island College seal stands for the life of the body and the life of the mind, symbolizing the human and intellectual goals and achievements of Rhode Island College.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted formal apparel which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long, pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertip. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS



JOHN COLLINS QUINN

John C. Quinn, who retired as editor-in-chief of *USA Today* and as president of Gannett News Service in 1990, will be remembered most as a pioneer who made landmark contributions to the field of journalism. The first edition of *USA Today* appeared in 1982 and was deluged by criticism from the journalism establishment. Ten years later, *USA Today* remains the second-highest circulation daily news in the United States and is distributed around the world.

Quinn was born in Providence, Rhode Island, on October 24, 1925. His career in journalism began in 1943, while he was still a student at Providence College, working at the *Providence Journal-Bulletin* as a copy boy. In 1945 he graduated cum laude from Providence College with a Bachelor of Arts degree. In 1946 he earned a Master of Science degree from Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism. Quinn then returned to the *Journal-Bulletin* and worked his way up through the ranks: reporter in the suburban offices, reporter in the city room, Washington correspondent, editor, city editor, and managing editor. "I never look back," Quinn says.

In 1966, after 23 years with the *Providence Journal-Bulletin*, Quinn joined ranks with Allen Neuharth, president of the Gannett Corporation and owner, at that time, of 87 daily newspapers across the country. Quinn's tenure with Gannett Corporation lasted 24 years until his retirement in 1990. Within that time he held key executive positions, including vice president for news, president of the Gannett News Service, and editor-in-chief of *USA Today*. Quinn is currently deputy chairman of The Freedom Forum, formerly titled the Gannett Foundation, an organization devoted to protecting, affirming, and extending freedom of press and speech.

Among the many awards to Quinn's credit are the Ida B. Wells Award (1991), the Editor of the Year by the National Press Foundation (1986), the Headliner Award from Women in Communications (1986), and the William Allen White Foundation Award for Journalistic Merit (1987). Quinn also holds honorary degrees from Providence College, Bryant College, and Roger Williams College.



NED ROREM

Time magazine has called Ned Rorem "the world's best composer of art songs." Yet his musical and literary ventures extend far beyond this specialized field to include symphonies, concertos, operas, ballets, choral works, and a variety of chamber compositions. He is the author of 12 books, among them, five volumes of diaries and collections of lectures and criticism.

Born in Indiana in 1923, Ned Rorem was brought up in Chicago. By the time Rorem was 10, his piano teacher had introduced him to the music of Debussy and Ravel, an experience which "changed [Rorem's] life forever." Rorem pursued advanced musical studies at Northwestern University, the Curtis Institute in Philadelphia, and the Juilliard School, where he received his Bachelor of Arts degree in 1946 and his Master of Arts in 1948.

In New York City Rorem worked as copyist for composer Virgil Thomson, whom he still considers to have been his principal mentor, according to music critic Steven Ledbetter. Rorem received orchestration lessons from Thomson along with a salary of \$20 a week. In 1948 Rorem's song "The Lordly Hudson" was voted the best published song of that year by the Music Library Association. He moved to France in 1949, and remained there until 1958, associating with leading artistic and social figures of postwar Europe, such as Cocteau, Poulenc, and Auric.

Rorem's career has been highlighted by a continuing series of awards: a Fulbright Fellowship to study with Arthur Honegger (1951), a Guggenheim Fellowship (1957), and an award from the National Institute of Arts and Letters (1968). He received the ASCAP-Deems Taylor Award in 1971 for his book *Critical Affairs, A Composer's Journal* and in 1975 for *The Final Diary*. Rorem's orchestral suite *Air Music* won the 1976 Pulitzer Prize, and a recording by the Atlanta Symphony of his *String Symphony, Sunday Morning*, and *Eagles* received a Grammy Award for the Outstanding Orchestral Recording of 1989.

Rorem's works have been performed by such noted conductors as Bernstein, Reiner, Ormandy, Stokowski, and Mehta. Commissions have come from the New York City Opera, the Ford Foundation, the Koussevitzky Foundation, Carnegie Hall, the Chicago Symphony, the Lincoln Center Foundation, WCRB-FM (Boston), and other distinguished organizations.

Long a resident of New York City, Rorem established a summer residence on Nantucket, where he now lives.



HONORABLE GEORGE N. LEIGHTON

The Honorable George N. Leighton retired as United States District Court judge in 1987, with a career of over 40 years in the judicial and legal professions and five honorary Doctor of Laws degrees. Now on the threshold of his 80s, Leighton stands as one of the exemplary personages of our times.

Born in 1912 in New Bedford, Massachusetts, the son of immigrants from the Cape Verde Islands, Leighton left school after the sixth grade to take a job on an oil tanker. He continued, however, to read extensively from borrowed books and he attended night schools from 1934 to 1935. In 1936 Leighton won an award of \$200 in an essay contest; the award provided initial tuition to any college of the winner's choice. At the age of 24, Leighton applied to Howard University and was accepted as an unclassified student. To his acceptance letter was added a postscript stating that he could only be admitted to degree candidacy by demonstrating he could keep up with the rigors of college work. Leighton did more than keep up; he made the Dean's List for four consecutive years and graduated magna cum laude in 1940, with a Bachelor of Arts degree.

In the same year Leighton entered Harvard Law School. But in 1942, when the country was in the midst of World War II, Leighton left Harvard for service in the Army. By the time he was discharged, in 1945, he had earned the rank of captain and was decorated with a Bronze Star. In 1945 he resumed study at Harvard and was awarded a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1946. In the same year he passed the Massachusetts Bar. In 1947 Leighton moved to Chicago and was admitted to the Bar of the State of Illinois.

From 1949 to 1951 Leighton served as an assistant attorney general of the State of Illinois; and in 1951 he organized a private practice, Moore, Ming & Leighton, predecessor to the law firm McCoy, Ming & Leighton (1959-1964). From 1953 until 1971 Leighton's firm was considered one of the largest predominantly black law firms in the United States. Leighton was also noted for his active involvement in cases concerning civil rights and constitutional law, many of which attracted national attention.

In 1964 Leighton moved from the bar to the bench when he was elected judge of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois. In 1969 he was appointed appellate judge to sit on the Appellate Court, First District of Illinois. In 1970 he was elected to a 10-year term as a justice of the Illinois Appellate Court. In 1976, after being nominated by then-president Gerald Ford, he was made U.S. District Court judge for the Northern District of Illinois. Today Leighton continues to serve both as counsel to the Chicago law firm Earl L. Neal & Associates and as special counsel to the chairman of the board of the Chicago Transit Authority.
