

ALAN SHAWN FEINSTEIN

Doctor of Pedagogy

Alan Shawn Feinstein is a nationally known philanthropist and humanitarian whose commitment to positive change — particularly with respect to service learning education programs and the alleviation of world hunger — has become legendary. With an academic background in both journalism and education from Boston University (B.S.) and Boston State College (M.S.), Feinstein began his career as a public school teacher in Massachusetts and Rhode Island and later founded an English school in Thailand. He authored a novel as well as several books for children. Entering the world of business and finance, he established a financial advisory newsletter in 1974 with \$500 in savings; this newsletter and other financial advisory publications became among the most widely circulated of their kind in the world, reaching a readership of over half a million. It is the revenue derived from these enterprises, which he closed in 1996 to devote his full attention to philanthropy, which serves as the basis of the Feinstein Foundation. To date, it is estimated that he has contributed more than \$50 million to charitable causes. Some of his better-known beneficiaries include the World Hunger Program at Brown University, the Feinstein International Famine Center at Tufts University, the Youth Hunger Brigade Program, the Congressional Hunger Center, the Feinstein High School for Community and Public Service in Providence, the Enriching America Program, and the Feinstein Institute for Public Service, among many others. Of special significance to Rhode Island College is his 1996 gift of \$1 million to endow the institution's School of Education and Human Development; this gift remains the largest private contribution in the history of the institution. Two years earlier, Feinstein contributed \$500,000 to provide funding for the establishment of the Joint RIC/URI Ph.D. program in education, which reaches a milestone at this year's Graduate Commencement as the College (collaboratively with the University) awards its first-ever earned doctoral degrees.



OSKAR EUSTIS

Doctor of Fine Arts

For the past five seasons Oskar Eustis has served as Artistic Director of Trinity Repertory Company, one of the nation's most renowned regional theatres and long regarded as the jewel in Rhode Island's cultural crown. At Trinity, productions directed by Mr. Eustis have included *Julius Caesar*, *Slavs!*, *Long Day's Journey Into Night*, *Voir Dire*, *Angels in America*, *Into the Woods*, *Ambition Facing West*, and *The Music Man*. Born in Minnesota in 1958, Eustis began his career as a child actor. In 1976 he moved to New York City and founded the Red Wing Theatre Company. He has served as director, dramaturg, and artistic director for theatres around the world, including the Laboratory Theatre Schauspielhaus of Zurich, Switzerland, the Eureka Theatre Company in San Francisco, and the Mark Taper Forum in Los Angeles. He has also directed productions at Actors Theatre of Louisville, Manhattan Theatre Club, East West Players, Berkeley Repertory, Berkeley Stage, Actor's Gang in Los Angeles, and others. He has won numerous awards for his work, including six Los Angeles Drama Critics Circle Awards and 11 Drama-Logue Awards for his L.A. production of *Angels in America*. His commitment to new play development has taken him to Utah's Sundance Institute and the Midwest Playlabs in Minnesota. As an academic, Eustis served as Associate Professor of Film, Television, and Theatre at UCLA; he has also taught at the University of California – Berkeley, the University of Alaska – Juneau, the University of California – Davis, San Francisco State University, San Jose State, and Pima Community College. Eustis' service to the theatre community includes a long association with the National Endowment for the Arts, and in 1988 he served as a judge for the Fulbright Fellowship. Eustis is a member of the Rhode Island Film Commission and an adjunct faculty member at Brown University. At Rhode Island College, he serves as Adjunct Professor of Theatre in the College's M.F.A. program, a collaborative program with the Trinity Repertory Conservancy, which just last year awarded its first degrees.

JOHN F. REED

Doctor of Public Service

Jack Reed was born in 1949 into a family which exemplified the best values of post-war working class America. A resident of Cranston since 1950, Reed attended St. Matthew's Elementary School, graduated from LaSalle Academy (where he was a star defensive safety on the football team), earned a B.S. from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 1971, and earned a Master of Public Policy from Harvard in 1973. From 1973 through 1977, Reed served as Infantry Platoon Leader, Company Commander, and Battalion Staff Officer in the 82nd Airborne Division while stationed at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He then returned to West Point where he joined the faculty as Associate Professor in the Department of Social Sciences. In 1979 Reed left the Army to attend Harvard Law School, where he received his J.D. in 1982. He practiced law in Washington, D.C., before returning to Rhode Island where he joined the firm of Edwards and Angell. He was elected to the Rhode Island Senate from Cranston in 1984 and served for three terms before his 1990 election to the U.S. Congress from the state's Second Congressional District, in which Rhode Island College is located. After three terms in Congress, Reed was elected to serve as Rhode Island's 47th United States Senator. Even as a freshman senator of the minority party, the respect with which Reed is held among his colleagues has brought him success in a number of important areas, including two proposals that were enacted as part of the 1998 reauthorization of the Higher Education Act. The Senator's other priorities include health care reform, particularly for uninsured children of working class families; economic development; and efforts to stem gun-related violence. A frequent visitor to this campus, Jack Reed is truly the heir to such illustrious Rhode Island emissaries to the United States Senate — and honorary alumni of Rhode Island College — as Theodore Francis Green, John O. Pastore, Claiborne deB. Pell, and John H. Chafee.



GEORGE WEIN

Doctor of Fine Arts

Jazz impresario George Theodore Wein, considered to be the “father” of the music festival format, has had an enormous impact on the national and international music scene. His festivals helped to develop and promote the careers of many legendary jazz artists, including Miles Davis, Duke Ellington, Mahalia Jackson, and many others. By pioneering the association of corporate sponsors with music events, Wein has vastly extended the reach of such artists to audiences worldwide. Forever known as the founder of the Newport Jazz Festival in 1954—the world’s first all-jazz music festival—Wein’s company, Festival Productions, Inc., today maintains offices in six cities and produces some 1,000 music events annually, including the JVC Jazz Festival in New York City and Newport, the New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival, Ben & Jerry’s Newport Folk Festival, and Newport Jazz Festivals in such cities as Sarasota, Florida, and in Rome and Torino in Italy. Next January, an event co-produced by Wein’s Festival Productions will be part of the Performing Arts Series at Rhode Island College. In 1973, Wein founded the New York Jazz Repertory Company and in 1982 he established the “Newport Jazz Festival All-Stars,” which has toured and recorded worldwide and which gives Wein an opportunity to showcase his own considerable skills on the piano. Wein has been honored at the White House on three occasions and has been awarded the *Legion d’Honneur* by France, where he was also inducted as a *Commandeur de L’Ordre des Arts et Lettres*. Among his numerous other honors are the Frederick Douglass Award from the New York Urban League, Maria Fisher Founder’s Award from the Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz, the Twentieth Century Golden Scroll Award from the *Boston Jewish Advocate*, and the Duke Ellington/Shepherd of the Flock Award for St. Peter’s Church Ministry in New York. In honoring George Wein, Rhode Island College underscores its commitment to the performing arts as it pursues the adoption of a new academic minor in jazz.



HELEN GINSBURG FORMAN

Doctor of Humanities

Helen Forman, a member of Rhode Island College's graduating Class of 1934, may very well be the embodiment of the ideal alumna. While perhaps most widely known for her 1994 quarter million dollar gift to the College to help fund the restoration of the East Campus building that now honors her late husband, Sylvan, who was a supervisor for the government in postal transportation, Helen long ago adopted the College as her second "family." Named by the Rhode Island College Alumni Association as its Alumna of the Year in 1989, Helen has been a tireless volunteer at College functions for many years. Her drive and persistence have often amazed those of more recent generations and her success during annual Alumni Fund phonathons is legendary. Forman is a lifelong learner; in addition to her bachelor's and master's degrees and certificate in gerontology from the College, Forman has studied at Providence College, the University of Rhode Island, Brown University, and the University of London, completing 90 hours of study beyond the master's degree. She was a special education teacher for 19 years before her retirement in the late 1970s and also served as a cooperating teacher for the College. She has endowed scholarships in the Department of Music, Theatre, and Dance and has also set up an endowment to help support The Forman Center. Helen Ginsburg Forman's contributions to the College in all their forms demonstrate a remarkable commitment to Rhode Island College and to its future students.



DAVID A. CAPALDI

Doctor of Pedagogy

David Arthur Capaldi is a 1964 graduate of Rhode Island College (B.Ed. in mathematics and physical sciences) and also earned his M.A.T. in mathematics (1967) and his C.A.G.S. in mathematics and mathematics education (1980) at the College. President of the Rhode Island College Alumni Association during 1972–73, Capaldi was also named to the 1992 RIC Alumni Honor Roll for Mathematics in the first year that such awards were given. Capaldi, who is retiring as Head of the Mathematics Department at Toll Gate High School in Warwick after a 35-year career as a teacher in that system, is considered by many to be an unofficial ambassador for mathematics education in Rhode Island. He has served as President of the Rhode Island Mathematics Teachers Association, President of the Association of Teachers of Mathematics in New England, Founder and Executive Director of the Rhode Island Mathematics and Science Education Coalition, President of the Warwick Education Association, and has been a member of the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics, the National Council of Supervisors of Mathematics, the Association for Women in Mathematics, as well as a number of other organizations. However, it is for his work in the classroom that David Capaldi has won his greatest acclaim. From his very first year at Gorton Junior High, when he was selected Teacher of the Year, Capaldi's commitment has been to his students; indeed, he has throughout his career declined numerous opportunities to pursue positions in administration. His honors include four Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching, a 1992 Milken Award for Excellence in Teaching, and the Rhode Island Commission on Women's Title IX Award. He was selected as Teacher of the Year a second time at Gorton Junior High, twice at Winman Junior High, and in 1994 won a student election as Toll Gate High School Educator of the Year. Capaldi's work in the classroom, in his academic specialty, and within the education profession make him a worthy role model for all teacher education students at Rhode Island College.



THE RHODE ISLAND COLLEGE SEAL

The official Rhode Island College seal, adopted in 1960, incorporates the anchor, a symbol of hope and of the state of Rhode Island, with the founding date of the institution, 1854. The seal was designed by Dr. Edith C. Becker, professor emerita of art, who adapted the central flame symbol from the Holbrook Murals in the foyer of Roberts Hall. The flame is used in the murals to depict the energy that has supported over the eons the development of all living things and has led man to his highest intellectual achievements. In like manner, the flame in the Rhode Island College seal stands for the life of the body and the life of the mind, symbolizing the human and intellectual goals and achievements of Rhode Island College.



THE DEL SESTO MACE

At the 1959 Commencement Exercises, the first held on the present Mount Pleasant campus, Governor Christopher Del Sesto presented to Rhode Island College a bronze replica of the statue of the Independent Man so that the College, which up to that time had been located near the State House, might continue its tradition of holding commencements and other academic convocations in the presence of the Independent Man. The Del Sesto Mace, designed by the noted Rhode Island sculptor, the late Aristide Cianfarani, and crafted by the Gorham Company, has been in use since 1962 in all academic processions as a symbol of tradition, authority, and of Rhode Island College's commitment to the search for truth, knowledge, beauty, values, and learning.

THE WILLARD MEDALLION

The Willard Medallion, a symbol of the office of the president worn at official and ceremonial occasions, links plates bearing the names of the chief executive officers, who have led Rhode Island College since 1973, in a sterling silver collar with an enamel medallion. It was commissioned by the Rhode Island College Alumni Association and designed by silversmith Curtis K. LaFollette, professor of art at the College, to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Charles Borromeo Willard as the first alumnus to be named president of the College.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted formal apparel which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long, pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertip. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's gown is worn open and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

The doctor's gown has rounded sleeves and velvet panels around the neck and down the front of the gown, as well as three velvet bars on the sleeves. In recent years American universities have followed the custom of European institutions of having doctoral gowns in the color of the university.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains.
