



LORNA DUPHINEY EDMUNDSON

**Doctor of Pedagogy**

Dr. Edmundson was inaugurated in 2001 as the 18th President of Wilson College, a woman-centered undergraduate institution located in the Cumberland Valley of Pennsylvania. A member of the Rhode Island College Class of 1964, Edmundson earned her master's degree in education from Boston College and Ed.D. from Columbia University Teachers College. After graduating from Rhode Island College, she taught in a Head Start program in Roxbury; served with the American Friends' Service Committee in Compton, California, following the 1966 Watts civil rights riots; served as a consultant with the New York City Schools in Ocean Hills-Brownsville and Harlem in Muslim, Haitian, Lutheran, Irish Catholic, Greek Orthodox, and Hasidic communities in the early 70s; developed internship programs for women at the American University of Paris, and lived in Algeria in the mid-1970s. She later served as a Fulbright Scholar in residence at Tokyo Women's Christian University in Japan. Professionally, Edmundson has served as president of the Association of Vermont Independent Colleges, as president of Trinity College of Vermont, and has held senior positions at the American University in Paris, Columbia University Teachers College School of General Studies, and Columbia University, Marymount, and Colby-Sawyer Colleges. In announcing Edmundson's selection as president of Wilson, the chair of the Board of Trustees said, "She has dedicated her life to women's education and has gained a global perspective on the role of women in today's world." Dr. Edmundson has been honored by the Rhode Island College Alumni Association as Outstanding Alumna and has been generous in support of her alma mater through the years.



THOMAS A. OHANIAN

**Doctor of Humanities**

Thomas Ohanian, who earned a Master of Science in instructional technology at Rhode Island College in 1988 and who also holds a Bachelor of Science from Boston University in broadcasting and film, is one of the most acclaimed leaders in the design and development of digital media products. His work has led to the widespread adoption of digital nonlinear editing equipment and digital media collaboration. The National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences awarded him an Emmy in 1994 for his invention of the Avid Media Composer, which revolutionized the field of professional video editing, replacing the use of videotapes with digital hard disks. In 1995 the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences honored him with an Academy Award for his invention of the Avid Film Composer. In 1998 he was awarded his second Emmy for the invention of the Avid Multicamera System, used for the editing of programs shot with multiple cameras. Ohanian is also an accomplished author, having written the acknowledged industry guidebook, *Digital Nonlinear Editing*, and is the co-author of *Digital Filmmaking*. These textbooks have sold in excess of 50,000 copies and, translated into Chinese, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Russian, and Spanish, are used in film and video schools throughout the world. He has also produced and directed *The Armenian Genocide: 1894-1896, 1915-1919*, a television documentary. He is also the author of a novel, *Lines in the Sand*, which is a love story set against the backdrop of World War I and the Armenian Genocide. In 1996 Mr. Ohanian was the recipient of the Dr. Thomas Kabakjian Award for Achievement in Science and Technology by the Armenian Students Association of America. Mr. Ohanian is currently vice president of Product Development at Digital Media on Demand (DMOD).

CAROLE MOSES HARMAN

**Doctor of Pedagogy**

Carole Moses Harman is a noted art educator and studio artist. With both a B.A. and M.A. in art education earned at the Rhode Island School of Design, the Brooklyn-born Harman came to Rhode Island in 1969 where she served as chair of the Art Department at Hope High School and later Central High School. She has also served professionally with the Rhode Island School of Design, Brown University, the Providence School Department, and most recently, as an adjunct teacher and College Supervisor of Student Teachers for the Department of Art at Rhode Island College. Her art work has been featured in numerous exhibitions, including exhibitions at the Providence Art Club, a solo exhibit at Dodge House, the Diva Gallery, the Chester Gallery, the Museum of Art at the Rhode Island School of Design, and others. She has received numerous awards, including the Juror's Award at the Rhode Island Art Educators Annual Juried Exhibit in 2000. Harman has been very active in the community, working with the John Hope Settlement House, Project New Urban Arts, the Citizens Bank/Central High School Business Education Partnership, BVA/RI, and City Wide Arts, among others. Ms. Harman has served as president of the Alumni Association of the Rhode Island School of Design and currently serves on the Board of Trustees of her alma mater. She has been recognized as the 1982–83 Teacher of the Year by the Providence School Department, Who's Who in Teaching in America, the Milken Family Foundation National Education Award, the Public Education Fund's Excellence in Education Teacher Award, and Who's Who in American Women.

**Doctor of Fine Arts**

Ms. Davis is a 1983 graduate of the Upward Bound program at Rhode Island College and a participant in the Preparatory Enrollment Program (PEP) who went on to earn her B.A. in theatre at the College in 1988 before continuing her education at the Juilliard School in New York. She has also performed in productions at the New York Shakespeare Festival, Lincoln Center, the American Conservatory Theatre (San Francisco), the Guthrie Theatre (Minneapolis), The Ahmanson Theatre (Los Angeles), and at Trinity Rep, where she appeared in *Joe Turner's Come and Gone* and *Measure for Measure*. She has appeared in numerous films, including Steven Soderbergh's 2000 film, *Traffic*, as well as the films *The Shrink is In*, *Out of Sight*, *Substance of Fire*, *Kate and Leopold*, and *Marvin's Room*. Upcoming films include *Fish*, directed by and starring Denzel Washington; *Far From Heaven*, with Julianne Moore; and the science fiction thriller *Solaris*, directed by Soderbergh and starring George Clooney. Her television work includes a regular role as nurse Lynette Peeler on the Steven Bochco series *City of Angels*, plus appearances on other television productions, including *Judging Amy*, *Third Watch*, *The Guardian*, *Providence*, *NYPD Blue*, *NY Undercover*, *Grace and Glory*, *Amy and Isabelle*, *The Division*, *Law and Order: Criminal Intent*, *The Pentagon Wars*, and a new pilot for CBS produced by Sylvester Stallone, *Father Lefty*. Ms. Davis was born in South Carolina and grew up in Central Falls.

HARRY KIZIRIAN

**Doctor of Public Service**

At the age of 15, the death of Harry Kizirian's father prompted him to enter the working world to help support his family. At the suggestion of a coach at Mt. Pleasant High School, he began working part-time in the Post Office while he kept up his grades at school and also achieved athletic excellence. Upon graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Marines, leading a fire team to victory on Okinawa even though sustaining multiple gunshot wounds in the battle. A month later, barely recovered from his wounds, he returned to battle to save a stretcher team of six Marines, but in so doing sustained severe wounds to his lower body, which kept him in and out of hospitals for many years upon his return to civilian life. His military heroism made him one of the nation's most decorated soldiers, being awarded the Navy Cross, the Bronze Star with a "V", the Purple Heart with a Gold Star, and the Rhode Island Cross, among others. Back in Rhode Island, he returned to service with the Post Office, eventually overseeing the transition to the nation's first Turnkey postal operation and later being appointed postmaster, a position he held from 1961 through 1986. Kizirian has been known for his extensive work with the community, including directorships with Butler Hospital, Big Brothers of Rhode Island, the Providence Human Relations Commission, Blue Cross of Rhode Island, the Rhode Island Heart Association, the Rhode Island Lung Association, and many others. He has served on the Providence Heritage Commission, the Commission on Rhode Island Medal of Honor Recipients, Disabled American Veterans, and the Marine Corps League. Kizirian is a generous supporter of Rhode Island College and serves as a trustee of the Rhode Island College Foundation. He is a recipient of the RIC Alumni Association's 1986 Alumni Service Award, is a member of the Rhode Island Heritage Hall of Fame, has received the Roger Williams Award, and has had the Camden Avenue School and the Turnkey Post Office in Providence named in his honor. Despite his accomplishments, the son of Armenian immigrants has said of himself, "I'm just an ordinary American boy who loves dealing with people from all walks of life."



## ACADEMIC ATTIRE

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted formal apparel which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long, pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertip. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's gown is worn open and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

The doctor's gown has rounded sleeves and velvet panels around the neck and down the front of the gown, as well as three velvet bars on the sleeves. In recent years American universities have followed the custom of European institutions of having doctoral gowns in the color of the university.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains.

## HONOR CORDS

Undergraduates who are receiving their degrees today with Latin honors have the privilege of wearing special "honor cords." The color of the cord indicates the level of the honor as follows:

Summa cum laude...gold

Magna cum laude...burgundy

Cum laude...white



#### THE RHODE ISLAND COLLEGE SEAL

The official Rhode Island College seal, adopted in 1960, incorporates the anchor, a symbol of hope and of the state of Rhode Island, with the founding date of the institution, 1854. The seal was designed by Dr. Edith C. Becker, professor emerita of art, who adapted the central flame symbol from the Holbrook Murals in the foyer of Roberts Hall. The flame is used in the murals to depict the energy that has supported over the eons the development of all living things and has led man to his highest intellectual achievements. In like manner, the flame in the Rhode Island College seal stands for the life of the body and the life of the mind, symbolizing the human and intellectual goals and achievements of Rhode Island College.



#### THE DEL SESTO MACE

At the 1959 Commencement Exercises, the first held on the present Mount Pleasant campus, Governor Christopher Del Sesto presented to Rhode Island College a bronze replica of the statue of the Independent Man so that the College, which up to that time had been located near the State House, might continue its tradition of holding commencements and other academic convocations in the presence of the Independent Man. The Del Sesto Mace, designed by the noted Rhode Island sculptor Aristide Cianfarani and crafted by the Gorham Company, has been in use since 1962 in all academic processions as a symbol of tradition, authority, and of Rhode Island College's commitment to the search for truth, knowledge, beauty, values, and learning.

#### THE WILLARD MEDALLION

The Willard Medallion, a symbol of the office of the president worn at official and ceremonial occasions, links plates bearing the names of the chief executive officers, who have led Rhode Island College since 1973, in a sterling silver collar with an enamel medallion. It was commissioned by the Rhode Island College Alumni Association and designed by silversmith Curtis K. LaFollette, professor of art at the College, to commemorate the inauguration of Dr. Charles Borromeo Willard as the first alumnus to be named president of the College.


