Riot in Donovan ends with hospitalization of Assistant Director

The problems in Donovan Dining Center began at 11:00 a.m. on March 31

a simple demonstration had turned into a full-blown riot. Director of Security Cy Cote directed all his men to the Dining Center as he entered the building from the Faculty Center doors with a

from the main dining room level. He was last seen standing on the center table and waving his arms in the air in a frantic attempt to stop a massive food fight.

Arguments continued to escalate and the North Providence Police were called in to assist the campus police officers who were already on the scene. Upon entering the building and seeing the mess, one officer was heard saying, "I bet they'll have curly fries from now on."

The rioting ended around 3:30 p.m., just in time for the Dining Center staff to begin preparing for the dinner crowds. Although the carpet was covered in ketchup, Donovan continued to cater to the clientele.

When reached for comment early in the evening, Vice President of Student Affairs Dr. Gary Penfield stated, "This was a very unfortunate situation. Before we judge the students' behavior, however, we need to consider their frustrations regarding the options available in Donovan."

When pressed to explain how he could condone such behavior, Dr. Penfield stated, "Actually, it's easy for me to empathize. I personally feel that macaroni and cheese should be on the menu far more often than it is. Don't misunderstand me - I don't think that jumping Arthur Patrie was the solution to this problem..."

Dr. Penfield was referring to the fact that Arthur Patrie was mauled by 12 students as he tried to close the service area during the incident. He was treated at nearby Fatima Hospital for a dislocated shoulder and a hematoma to his head. He was released from the hospital later in the evening.

Sharon Taraksian, Director of Purchasing, told Canchor staff members that she has already accepted a bid from the Fries 'R Us company. In order to ensure that nothing like this happens again, the contract calls for delivery of one ton of curly fries per day.








