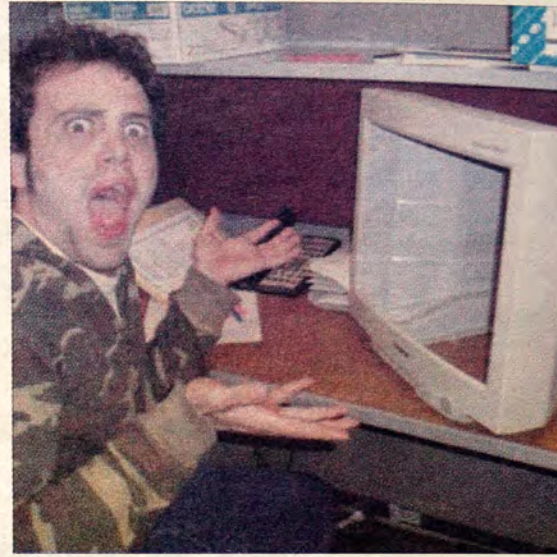
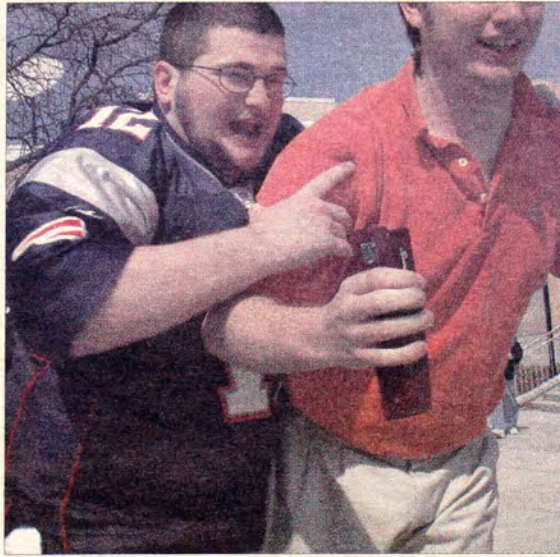

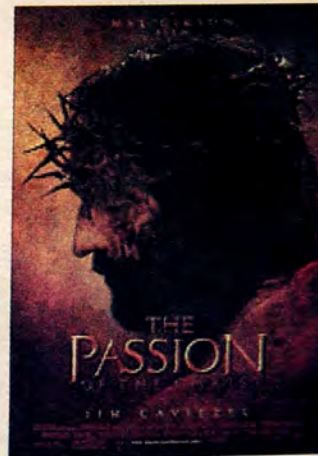
"If I hadn't seen it for myself, I would've dismissed all the hype as just holy wishful thinking," Barr said sternly, "until I ate at the cafeteria... and

Jimmy Hoffa Found! John Nazarian the Kidnapper?

An enormous discovery was made on Monday on the Quad of Rhode Island College's campus while students and faculty were playing in the sand pit mentioned in Sara Corrigan's piece. cat/dog fights could possibly be dangerous to the students and staff, school officials feel the dog-walking threat is much more dangerous.

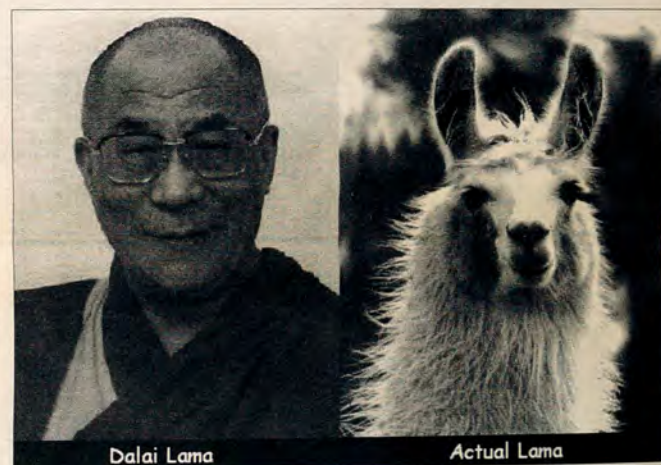
