SOCCER 1965

This year's soccer team, although plagued by a minimum of experience, showed improvement in many areas. Above all, Coach Ed Bogda's team showed that lack of experience can be more than compensated for by hard-playing, determination, and an optimistic attitude. These traits certainly were brought out during the second game against Salem State. The opposition had previously beaten RIC on their own field by a 5-0 score. Expecting to do the same at RIC's field, the Salem Witches went home very surprised and disgusted at the end of the game, with the final score RIC 0 and Salem 0 in a double overtime battle.

The Anchormen managed to tie the Alumni by a score of 2-2. Always a tough game, because of the Alumni's determination and drive, the Anchormen showed the "old greats" that the varsity wasn't a brush-off.

The key words for this year's team might be determination and defense. In clutch situations, Ray Patrone could be

expected to come up with a key save; he could be counted on to take over as field general. John Foley, a newcomer to the soccer team this year, showed one of the best examples of determination on the field; his spirit and constant defensive moves were an asset to his fullback position. Mike Lenihan, although hampered by two sprained ankles this season, came up with some key plays at the other fullback position. Never to be forgotten is the never-ending effort and defensive work of Fred Santaniello—even though he was always thirsty—and Bob Marchand, two more newcomers to the team.

The forward line attack led by Jimmy Wade, Frank Short at the inside position, Don Vanasse, and Dave Colardo at the wing positions, certainly gave their best to put RIC on the scorebooks. Frank Joseph, Bob Manocchia, and the other substitutes provided extra help at times when they were needed.



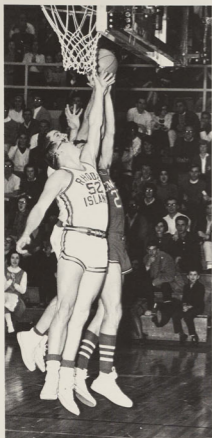

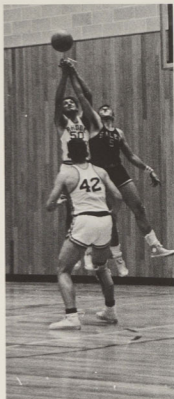

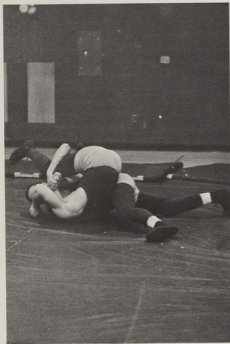

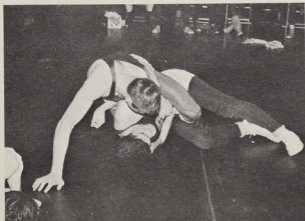

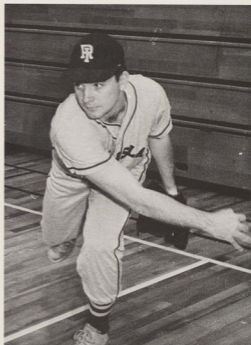

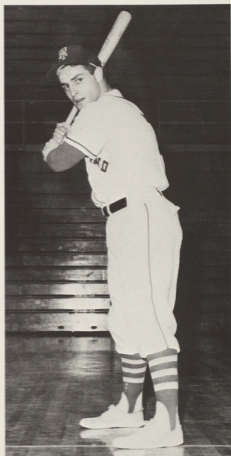
