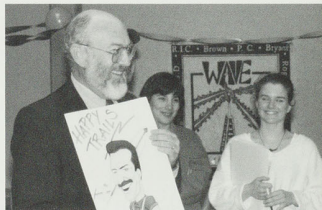
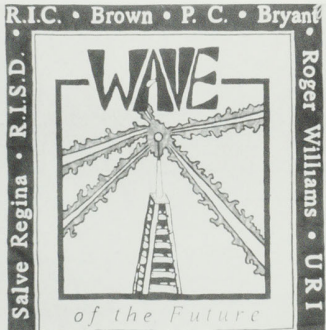




# Doug's Farewell Party

# Brunch Bowl/ OlympRICs

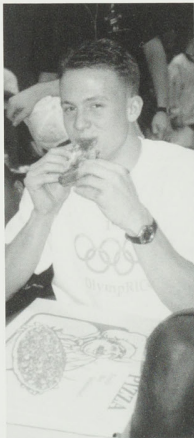

# 1994 Undergraduate Commencement

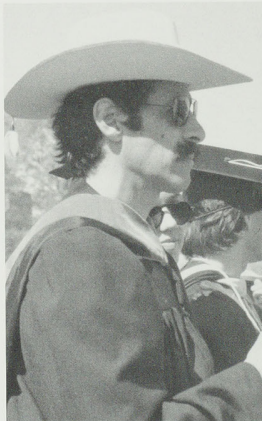
