## 1999-00 Pre-Season Outlook

New Head Coach **Jay Jones** takes over the Rhode Island College wrestling program with high expectations. Jones inherits a team that was 0-13 overall, 0-4 in the Pilgrim Wrestling League and placed 14th at the 1999 New England College Conference Wrestling Association (NECCWA) Championships.

Jones says, "The coaching staff is looking forward to the challenge of building the Rhode Island College wrestling program back to New England Championship caliber."

The team returns four letter-winners, all of which were starters a year ago. The squad will be captained by **A.J. Aulson** and **Sean Magee**. Aulson, who competes at 141 pounds, was having a solid season in '98-99 before breaking his hand and missing the remainder of the year. Magee is an experienced veteran at 133 pounds who returns to the lineup after sitting out last winter.

**Troy Lambert** was a bright spot for RIC at 157 pounds, placing fifth in New England at the '99 NECCWA Championships. **Jay Giroux** will compete for a spot at 149 pounds. Giroux was off to a solid start last season before a neck injury sidelined him for the rest of the year. **Joe Manzello**, who started as a freshman in '98-99, will compete at 149 pounds this year. **Chad Lampert** returns to the squad after red-shirting last season.

The team also has a talented group of newcomers on the mat this winter. **Stephen Signore**, from North Providence High School, will likely compete at 174 pounds. **Radbeh Torabi**, from Cranston High School West, will likely start at 165 pounds. **Chris Richard**, from Coventry High School, is an outstanding wrestler at 157 pounds. **Mike Penza**, from Cranston High School East, will start at 184 pounds. **Craig Henault**, from Burrillville High School, will compete at 125 pounds.

The Anchormen will open the season at the Roger Williams Invitational on Nov. 13.

## 1999-00 Pre-Season Outlook

Head Coach **Kim Zeiner-Daigle** begins the season with almost an entirely new team. The Anchorwomen return three letterwinners, all of which were starters. With the influx of new talent, the Anchorwomen are hoping to qualify for the National Collegiate Gymnastics Association (NCGA) Championships as a team for the fourth time in the past five years.

The Anchorwomen will have to cope with the loss of two-time All-American **Amy Bright** and outstanding gymnasts **Michelle Pelletier** and **Kate Goyette** who finished their eligibility last season. **Alicia DeFronzo**, the club's lone senior in 1999-00, will likely miss the entire season with a back injury she suffered over the summer.

**Anita Chase**, the team captain, will be counted upon to lead the team. Chase will compete in all four events. **Elise Arruda**, perhaps the team's top gymnast, is expected to have an outstanding season. Arruda qualified for the 1999 NCGA Championships on beam as an individual. **Kristen Oliver**, who joined the team in January of last season, will also compete in the all-around.

Newcomers **Sajdah Ahmad** and **Shannon Hughey** will also start and compete in the all-around. Ahmad is a freshman standout from New London, Connecticut and Hughey is a sophomore from Warwick, Rhode Island.

**Cara Collins**, **Jessica Frey**, **Jennifer Monty** and **Sara Olink** are newcomers to the team this winter who will add depth to the lineup.

The Anchorwomen will open the season at home against Brown University on Monday, Dec. 6 at 7:30 p.m.

## 1999-00 Pre-Season Outlook

Head Coach **Mike Kelley's** women's basketball team enters the season with six returning letter-winners, two of which were starters. The Anchorwomen will have to replace **McLeah Hall**, **Sarah Kelly**, **Nicole Taylor**, who finished their eligibility last winter, if the team is to be successful. RIC was 17-9 overall and 8-6 (fourth place) in the Little East in 1998-99.

**Jen Cook** and **Christine Martin** have been starters at the forward positions since their rookie year in 1996-97. Cook was third on the team in both scoring and rebounding a year ago. Martin was second in rebounding and fourth in scoring in 1998-99.

**Erica Waltonen** will be back in the lineup after missing almost the entire season last year with an injured hip. Freshman **Guyflore Xavier**, a top recruit from Avon High School, will also challenge for a starting job at forward.

**Meaghan Davis** will step into a starting role at guard/forward after coming off of the bench the previous three seasons. **Beth Iacoi** will assume the starting point guard duties. **Lauren Brown** will also see time as a reserve at either guard or forward.

**Melanie Costa**, **Stephanie Callaghan**, **Alicia Hersperger** and **Melanie Wolf** will all see time at guard in Coach Kelley's up-tempo style.

The Anchorwomen will open the season against Springfield College in the opening round of the Williams College Tournament on Nov. 20.

## 1999-00 Pre-Season Outlook

The Anchormen enter the 1999-00 season with almost an entirely new squad from last season. Head Coach **James Adams** begins his 21st year as the Anchormen's Head Coach with only two returning lettermen and one returning starter. RIC was 6-19 overall and 2-12 (eighth place) in the Little East in 1998-99.

Forward **Steve Clarke** will captain the team this winter. Clarke averaged 7.0 points and 5.9 rebounds as the squad's starting power forward in 1998-99. Forward **Matt Barrette** averaged 2.2 points and 2.4 rebounds in 13 games after joining the squad last January. Guard **Eric Greene** rejoins the team this winter after not playing last season.

Freshman forwards **Mike Hendershot** and **Ramaal Layne** are likely candidates to earn spots in the starting frontcourt. Freshman **Chris Robinson** is a hustling forward who will also see plenty of action this year. **Stephen Bacon** and **Mike Costigan** will add depth to the lineup.

Freshman **Peter Mollo** will push for the starting point guard duties. Freshman **James Heady** is a sharp-shooting guard who may also start. **Jeremy Anderson**, **Chris Darigan** and **Pat Hodge** will add depth to the backcourt.

RIC opens the first season of the new millennium at the College of New Jersey Tournament on Nov. 19 and 20. The Anchormen will battle host TCNJ in the opening game at 7:00 p.m. on Nov. 19.

### 2000 Pre-Season Outlook

The Rhode Island College softball team raised the bar for the program's expectations after posting a 22-19 overall record and an 8-6 (fifth place) mark in the Little East Conference in 1999. Head Coach **Maria Morin's** team set school records for the most victories in a single season and qualified for the ECAC post-season tournament for the first time in the program's history last spring.

"I think we achieved some respect on a regional level last year," Coach Morin says. "We took a big step and hope to continue last year's success into this season."

Senior **Rachel Medeiros**, last year's team MVP, will start at first base. **Katie Costigan** has earned the starting duties at second base as only a freshman. Senior **Jen Cook** is an All-LEC shortstop. Sophomore **Kelly McCaskill** has the inside track to start at third base. Freshman **Michele Fanelli** and sophomore **Christine Shields** will see plenty of time as utility infielders.

Freshman **Hollie Benevides** will start in leftfield. **Meaghan Davis** makes the switch from rightfield to centerfield. **Crissy McCullah** and **Jen Siciliano** will battle for the starting duties in rightfield.

Junior **Lea Wiggins** is the club's ace and one of the best strikeout pitchers in the LEC. **Beth Covill** will be the team's number two starter. Senior **Jen Sabatelli**, who has an excellent arm, is a returning All-Conference catcher.

Head Coach **Scott Perry's** team begins the first season of the new millennium with several new faces around the diamond. The Anchormen are hoping to improve upon last spring's 11-23 overall record and 4-10 mark in the Little East Conference.

**Mike Henderson**, who is a transfer from CCRI, will most likely start at first base and provide some power in the batting order. **Andy Barron** moves over to second base from third. ## 1999 Pre-Season Outlook

Head Coach **Dick Ernst** enters his tenth campaign with a solid team that should challenge for the conference championship. "This is a very focused group of individuals on this team," Ernst says. "They've been working hard all pre-season and their goal is to win the Little East."

The Anchorwomen finished second, just three points shy of the champion UMASS-Dartmouth team in 1998. RIC posted a 10-2-1 overall record last fall and had at least one player reach the finals match in every flight at the LEC Championships.

**Trisha Haworth** returns for her final year of collegiate tennis as the team's number one singles player. Haworth fell in the finals match of both the number one singles and doubles flights at the LEC Championships last year. With a solid season, Haworth should become RIC's all-time career points leader.

**Cynthia Murray** will compete at number two singles. Murray was the LEC Champion at number three doubles last fall. **Lisa Vinacco** will compete at number three singles. Although this is her first year of collegiate tennis, Vinacco has competed in USTA women's leagues for several years.
