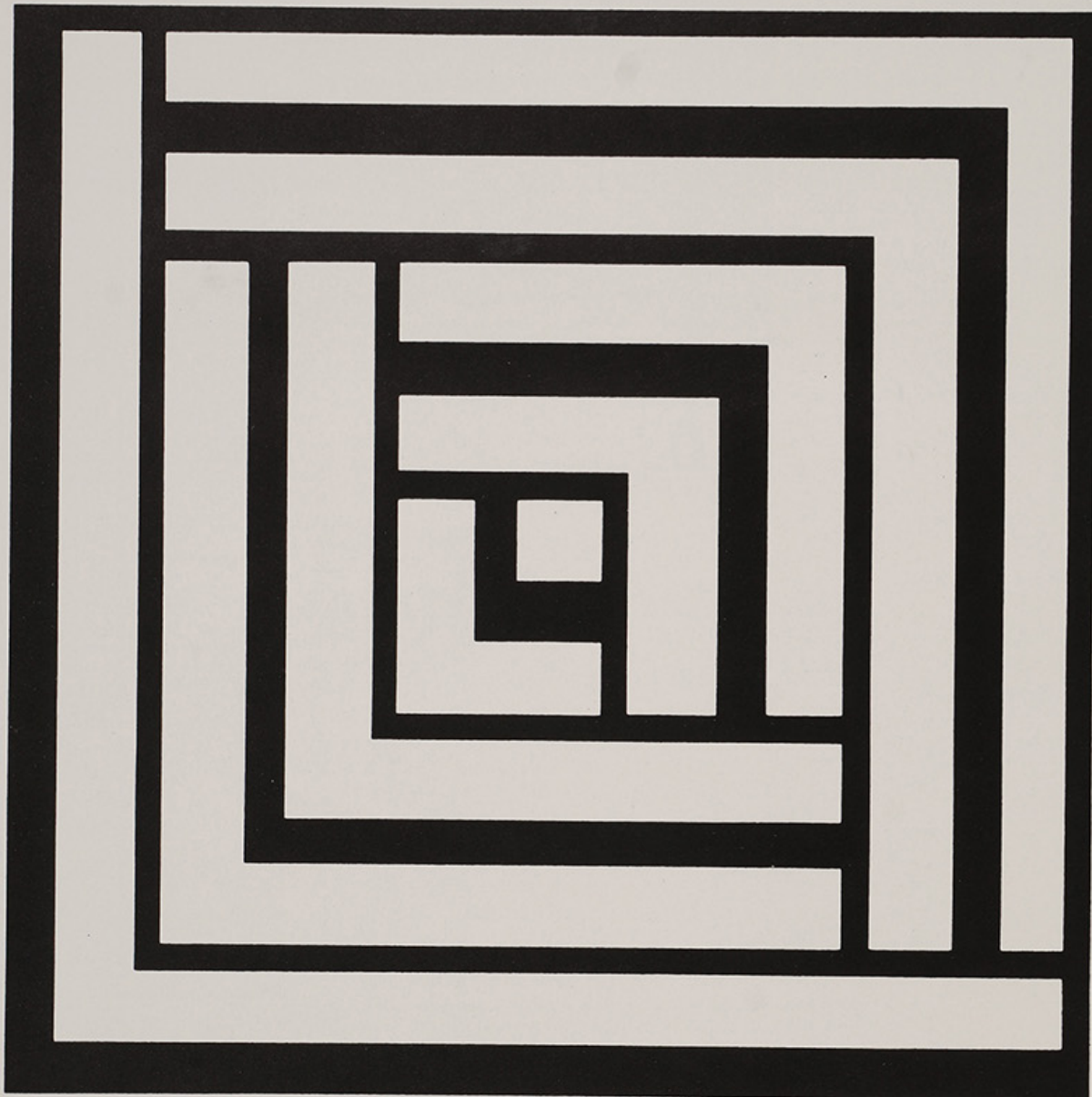

There is an inane but common conception of involvement as a group activity; and this, in spite of the fact that involvement is essentially a function of the individual, in which he always remains himself, retains his integrity and perhaps extends his awareness, gains in understanding through the experience.

Involvement has nothing to do with romantic politics or material success . . . It stems from the knowledge or recognition of the sacredness of a person, of yourself first, and therefore of every other person.

Involvement is not a game. It requires a man of character, for implicit in involvement is a confrontation of the individual with himself, and developing from this is the acceptance, or rejection, of the responsibility for preserving the humanity of yourself and of each and every other one.

THE YEAR

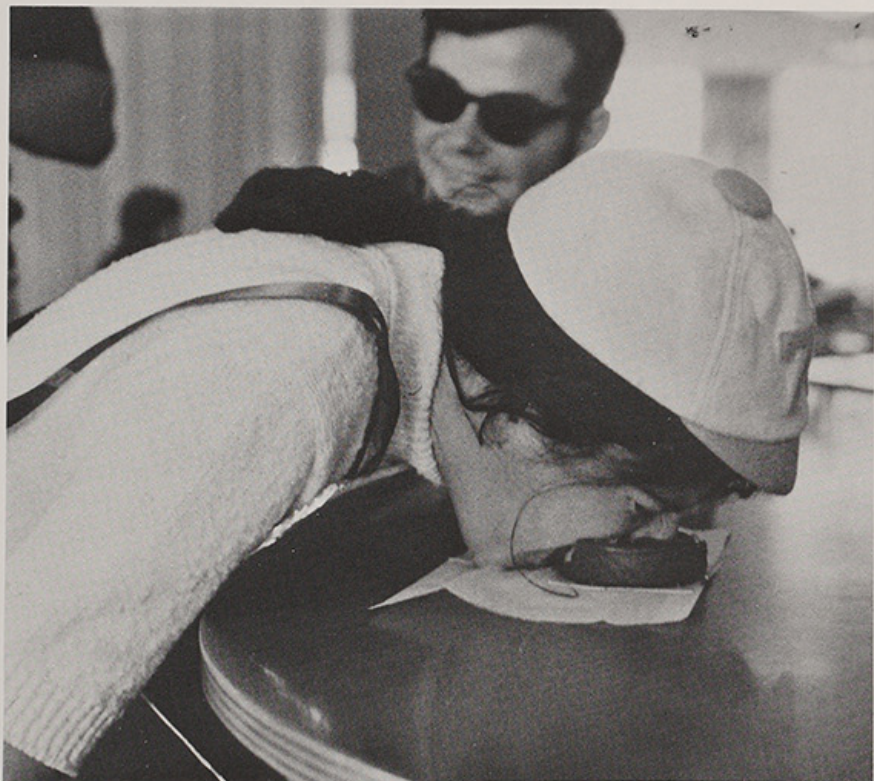

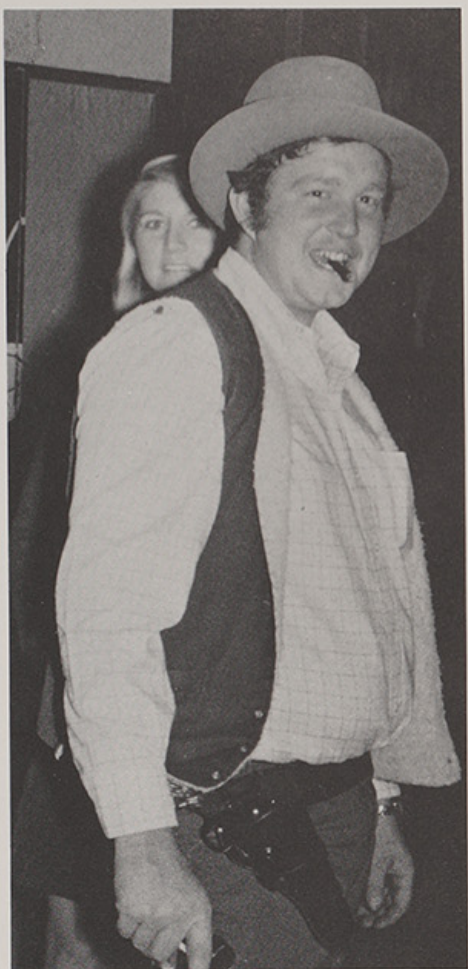
E G I S T R A T I O N

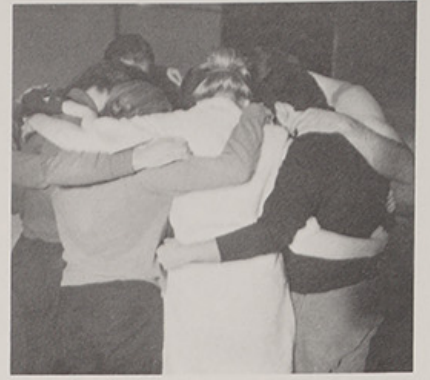

HOMECOMING

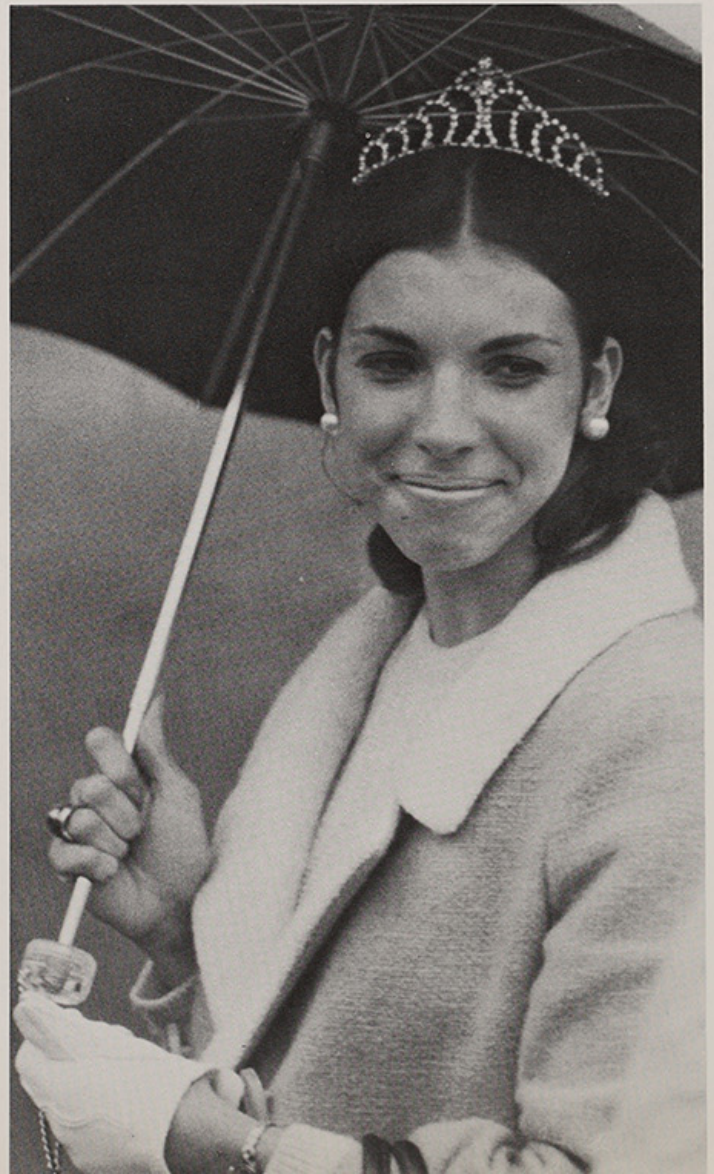

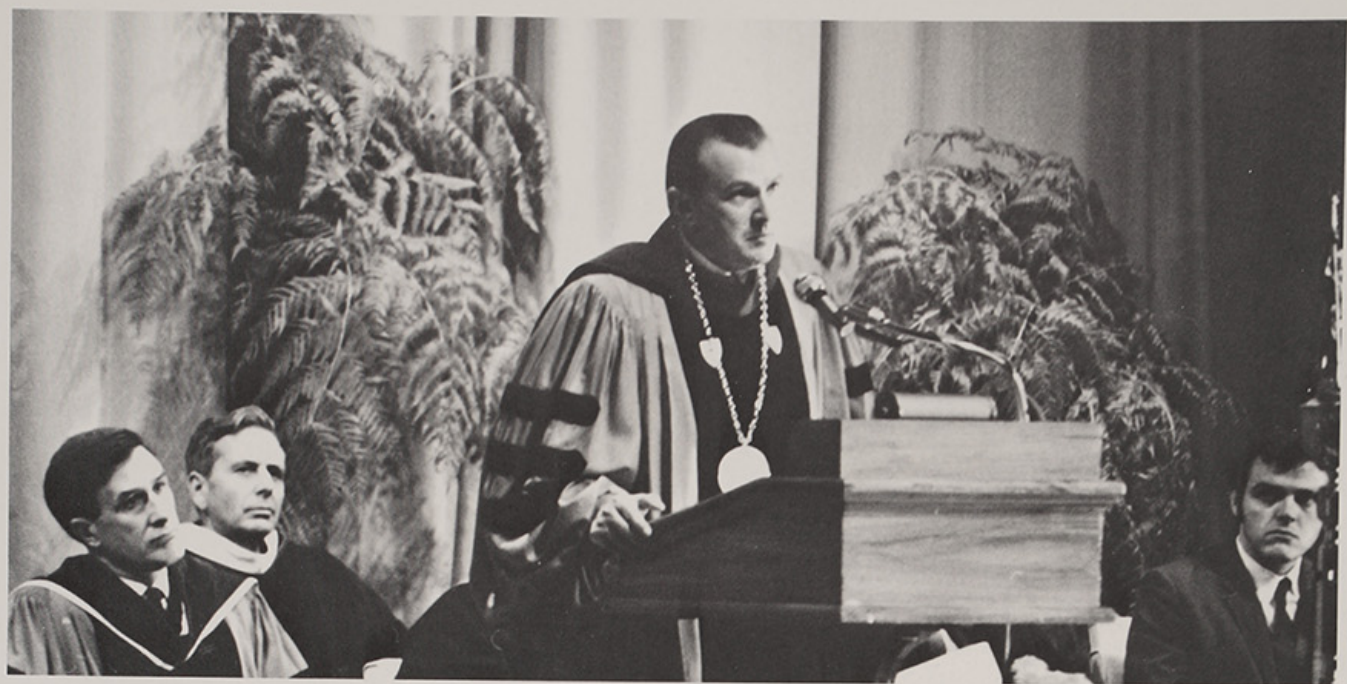
INAUGURATION OF A PRESIDENT

1968 belongs to new presidents. While the nation was involved in choosing its Chief, Rhode Island College was welcoming its own new President, Dr. Joseph M. Kauffman, former Dean of Student Affairs at the University of Wisconsin.

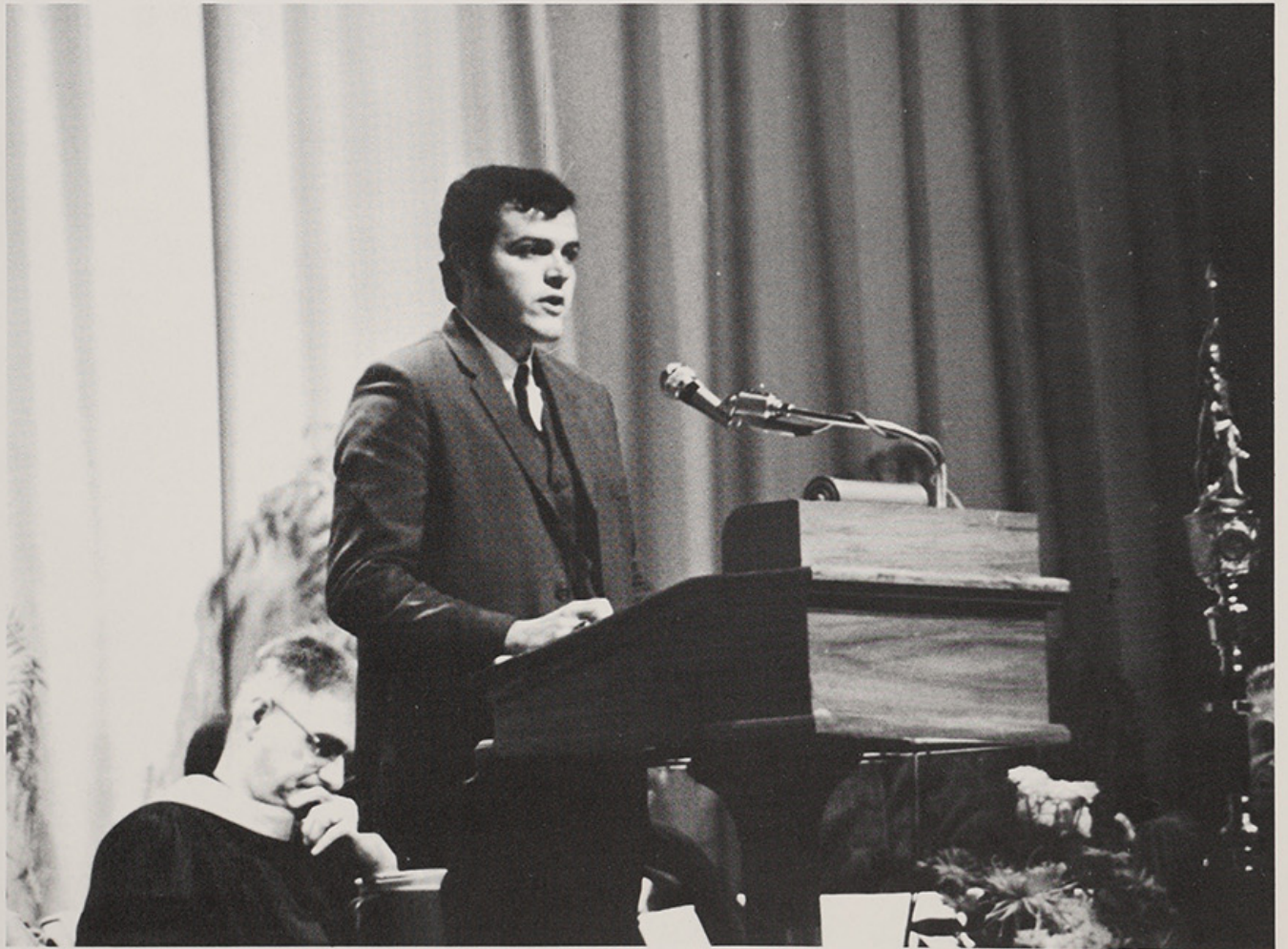
President-elect Kauffman arrived quietly in July to undertake his executive duties; however, it wasn't until November that the college invested him as its fourth president. To mark the occasion of the Inauguration, the college organized a week-long series of programs in Dr. Kauffman's honor. A craft exhibition in the art gallery of the James P. Adams Library ushered in the festivities, while an Inaugural Eve recital was presented by concert pianist, Carol Jane Buffkins.

The Inauguration ceremony itself, held on November 27th at 2:30 p.m. featured John U. Monro, Director of Fresman Studies at Miles College in Birmingham, Alabama, as the principal speaker. Administrators and Presidents, Deans and other educators throughout the nation attended. Secretary of the Navy, and former Governor of Rhode Island, John Chaffee addressed the notable assemblage, while Dr. Ronald Ballinger officiated as master of ceremonies.

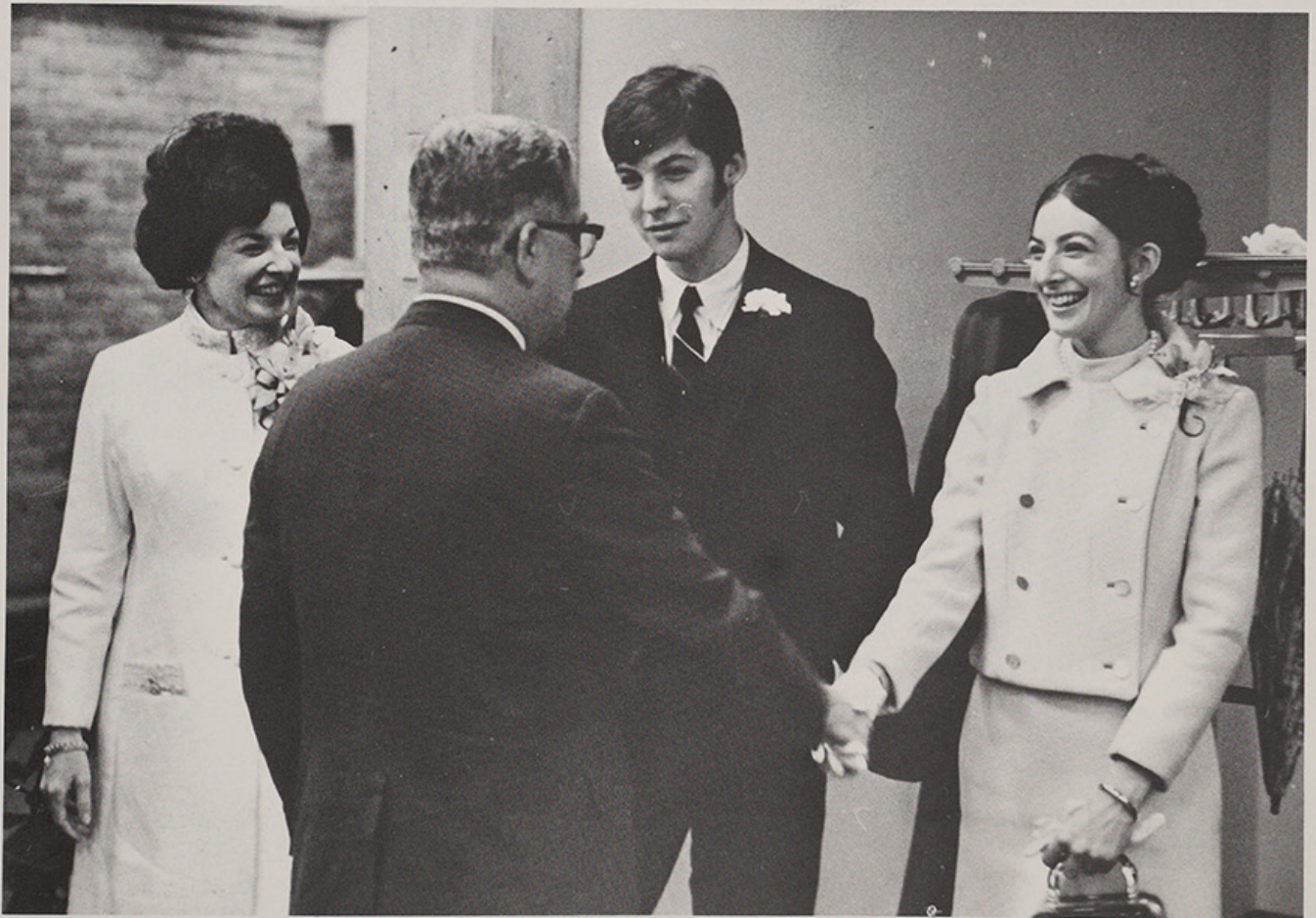

Following the ceremonies, a late afternoon reception was given in the Student Union. The Inaugural dinner ensued. IN MEMORIAM

James P. Adams died on February 27, at the age of 74. Born in Carson City, Michigan on January 27, 1895, Dr. Adams was a well known figure on the Rhode Island College campus. He served as Chairman of the Board of Trustees of State Colleges and retired in 1960.

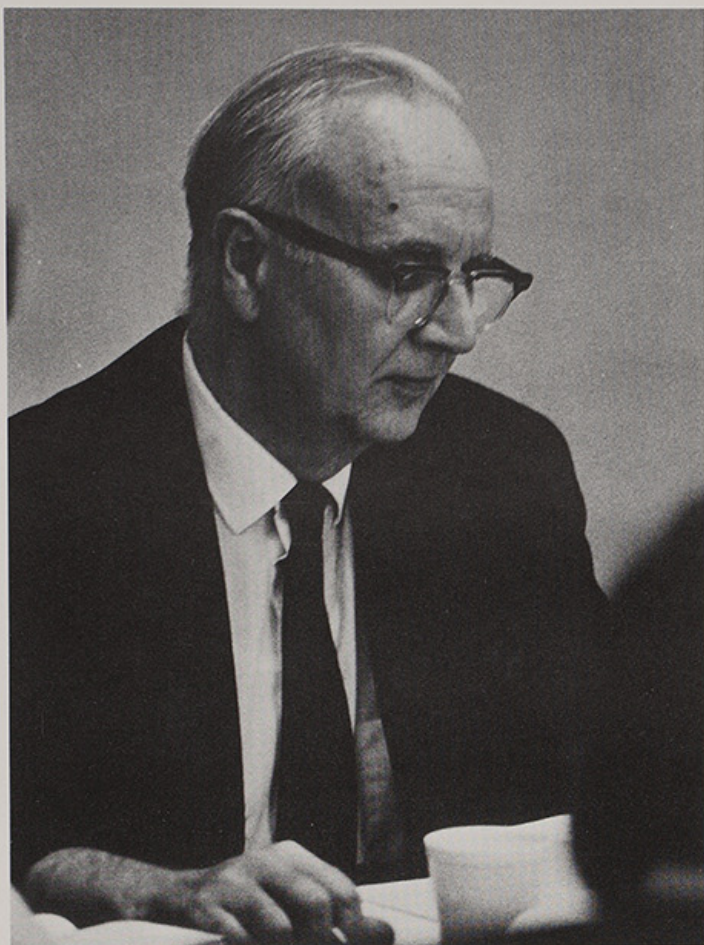
When Dr. Adams retired as Chairman in 1960, the Providence Journal said in an editorial: "In five years of service to Rhode Island, Dr. Adams has managed to make a contribution to education which few men have made in whole lifetimes of service. That this public service capped a personal career of distinction only underlines his high competence."

On May 7, 1963, Rhode Island College dedicated the James P. Adams Library which remains a fitting memorial to a truly great man.
